School Uniform

It is an expectation that all children wear full school uniform. School uniform helps to create a sense of belonging and pride in our school community. It promotes equality and reduces pressure around fashion choices. Uniform also supports safety by making pupils easily identifiable on school trips and around the school site. Most importantly, it reinforces our shared values and helps children feel part of the Stanwell Fields family.

Logo school uniform items can be purchased via the school office. All other items are available from high street retailers. **Please make sure all items of uniform are labelled with your child's name and class.**

School Uniform:

- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan with the school logo
- White polo shirt with or without the school logo
- Grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore
- Black school shoes or plain black trainers
- Grey or white socks
- Grey tights

PE Kit

- Royal blue t-shirt with the school logo
- Plain black sports shorts or tracksuit bottoms (no lycra or leggings)
- Grey or white socks
- Black plimsolls or black trainers

Please note:

- Long hair must be tied back and hair accessories should be discreet and school colours
- Hijabs should be navy blue or black
- A small wristwatch may be worn (no 'smart' watches)
- Small studs may be worn in pierced ears but need to be removed for PE days
- No jewellery, make-up or nail polish/stick-ons/gel or acrylic nails

Thank you for your support in ensuring children come to school wearing the correct uniform each day.

Mobile Phones

Stanwell Fields is a mobile phone-free school.

Pupils

Year 6 pupils who have permission to walk to and/or from school unaccompanied may bring a mobile phone to school. Phones must be switched off and handed in to the school office on arrival, where they will be stored securely during the day. They will be returned by Year 6 class teachers at the end of the school day.

Parents

We also kindly ask parents and carers not to use mobile phones whilst on the school site. This helps ensure full attention is given to the supervision of children and supports a safe and welcoming environment for everyone. Thank you for your cooperation and support.

Free School Meals Checker



Eligibility for Free School Meals has been expanded to include families in receipt of Universal Credit. Please complete the Microsoft Form that has been emailed to you. **We encourage all parents to submit the form, even if your child does not wish to have a school dinner.** This is because the school also receives additional funding, which helps support your child's education and enables us to provide additional resources and opportunities for all pupils.
